ILSI REACH Regulation Compliance

Dear Customer,

On June 1, 2007, the European Commission released new legislation addressing the registration, evaluation, authorization and restriction of chemical within the European Union community. This regulation is commonly referred to as REACH (Registration, Evaluation and Authorization of Chemicals)

ILSI has determined that ILSI products (Articles) are compliant to the regulations and do not require registration. ILSI does not directly export chemicals to the EU but articles (Frequency Control Products) which are electronic components. There is no intended release of substance or preparations from the ILSI products under normal or foreseeable conditions of use.

Based on a review of the supplier provided data and to the best of our knowledge, ILSI products do not contain any of the Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) as defined in Article 33 and revised as of 15 December 2010.
